The cause of the fire is still under investigation but was presumed to be a lightning strike.

Craig is a self-employed lighting technician who worked out of his home and is uninsured. Unfortunately, he lost all of his business equipment and tools along with his radio shack. Only his clothes and a few personal items were salvageable.
