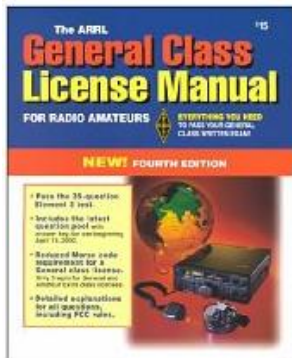

Congratulations on obtaining your Technician license and becoming an Amateur Radio Operator! You have probably realized that while you have been given the authority to get on the air, you are also somewhat limited in the frequencies you can operate. More importantly, most of your communications are limited to the line of sight propagation of VHF/UHF.

The Jupiter Tequesta Repeater Group (JTRG) is ready to help you move to the next level and reach out to the world! To do so, we'll be conducting a weekend class to help you upgrade from Technician to a General class.



JTRG will provide the instructors and our experience, but this is a VERY compressed class and essentially a structured review. To be successful, you must invest your time prior to the class by purchasing AND READING the General Class License Manual.
